

A RESOLUTION

APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE MILE HIGH FLOOD DISTRICT, DENVER, AND AURORA FOR WET WEATHER MONITORING AND OTHER STORMWATER QUALITY PERMIT ACTIVITIES

WHEREAS, § 29-1-203, Colorado Revised Statutes, provides that "Governments may cooperate or contract with one another to provide any function, service, or facility lawfully authorized to each of the cooperating or contracting units, including the sharing of costs, the imposition of taxes, or the incurring of debt . . . for any period of time" if such agreements are authorized by each party thereto with the approval of its legislative body or other authority with the power to approve;

WHEREAS, the Joint Task Force (JTF) consisting of; the City of Lakewood, City and County of Denver, the City of Aurora, and the Mile High Flood District entered into a joint funding intergovernmental agreement (IGA) in 1993 for wet weather monitoring and educational outreach;

WHEREAS, the JTF parties have periodically entered into an IGA to fund and collaborate on similar efforts;

WHEREAS, an IGA is again proposed to continue the collaborative efforts for wet weather monitoring and other activities;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to approve the currently proposed IGA for additional funding; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds and determines that authorizing the City Manager to execute said IGA is in the best interest of the City of Lakewood.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Colorado, that:

SECTION 1. The Intergovernmental Agreement Regarding Funding of Joint Wet Weather Monitoring and Other CDPS Permit Activities is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into the IGA on behalf of the City.


SECTION 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately after signature upon its adoption.


