A RESOLUTION

APPOINTING A PRESIDING MUNICIPAL JUDGE TO THE LAKEWOOD MUNICIPAL COURT

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the Lakewood Municipal Court by virtue of the retirement of Presiding Municipal Court Judge Anne Stavig;

WHEREAS, Article V of the Charter for the City of Lakewood provides that the City Council shall designate a Presiding Municipal Judge, who shall serve in such capacity at the pleasure of the City Council, and such Presiding Municipal Judge shall be responsible for department director duties associated with the municipal court, including establishment of a department budget, appointment of a Court Administrator and selection of associate, limited, and special judges for the municipal court;

WHEREAS, the City Council appointed a Judicial Nominating Committee for the purpose of recommending nominees to be considered by the City Council for appointment as the Presiding Municipal Judge through Resolution 2022-21;


WHEREAS, the Judicial Nominating Committee reviewed the applications, interviewed candidates, and recommended three (3) nominees to the City Council; and

WHEREAS; following interviews and consideration of each of the nominees the City Council selected a candidate to serve as the Presiding Municipal Judge for the Lakewood Municipal Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lakewood:

1. Nicole Bozarth is hereby appointed as the Presiding Judge for the Municipal Court of the City of Lakewood.
2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


