A RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING A SEPARATION STUDY BETWEEN THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD AND XCEL ENERGY (PSCO)

WHEREAS, the City of Lakewood (the "City") as directed by the Lakewood City Council (the "City Council") is evaluating acquisition of its street lights; and

WHEREAS, on June 16, 2021, the City provided notice to Xcel Energy of its intent to acquire the street lights; and

WHEREAS, Xcel Energy has requested that a Separation Study is conducted as the next step in the evaluation and acquisition process.

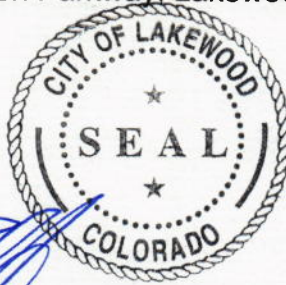
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Colorado, that:


SECTION 1. A separation study shall be conducted for acquiring the City of Lakewood's street lighting system with a not to exceed cost of \$280,000.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to sign the Separation Study Scope of Work on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


