A RESOLUTION

APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE MILE HIGH FLOOD DISTRICT, THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER, AND THE CITY OF SHERIDAN FOR A MAJOR DRAINAGEWAY PLAN AND A FLOOD HAZARD AREA DELINEATION FOR BEAR CREEK DOWNSTREAM OF BEAR CREEK RESERVOIR

WHEREAS, the City of Lakewood has enacted floodplain management regulations, and the Mile High Flood District (MHFD) has expressed its intent to assist the City in the implementation of said regulations, and

WHEREAS, the City of Lakewood wishes to cooperate with the Mile High Flood District, the City and County of Denver, and the City of Sheridan to identify solutions to stormwater drainage and flood control management for Bear Creek Downstream of Bear Creek Reservoir by preparation of a Major Drainageway Plan and a Flood Hazard Area Delineation (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the proposed Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) includes a contribution by the City of Lakewood not to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000); and

WHEREAS, the City's anticipated contribution of funds were included in the Lakewood 2023 approved budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Colorado, that:


SECTION 1. Authorizing the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) for a major drainageway plan and a flood hazard area delineation for Bear Creek Downstream of Bear Creek Reservoir is in the best interest of the residents of the City.


SECTION 2. The IGA is hereby approved, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute said agreement on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3. The City Treasurer is hereby authorized to make payment to the Mile High Flood District in accordance with the terms of said IGA.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.




