A RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS ALONG SHERIDAN BOULEVARD BETWEEN JEWELL AVENUE AND FLORIDA AVENUE

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 29-1-203, the City of Lakewood (the "City") and the Colorado Department of Transportation ("CDOT") have the authority to enter into intergovernmental agreements (IGAs);

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration approved CDOT's Surface Transportation Improvement Program ("STIP"), and authorized federal funding for the same;

WHEREAS, the City of Lakewood applied for a federal grant to add a shared-use path along the west side of Sheridan Boulevard from Jewell Avenue to approximately one block of South Florida Avenue (the "Project");

WHEREAS, the City's application for federal grant funding for the Project was approved subject to the requirement that the City enter into an IGA with CDOT for the use of STIP funds;

WHEREAS, the City and CDOT negotiated an IGA outlining all terms and conditions for the Project attached hereto as Attachment A;

WHEREAS, the proposed IGA includes a contribution by the City not to exceed four hundred eighty four thousand dollars (\$484,000.00), and a CDOT contribution of federal funds not to exceed one million, nine hundred thirty six thousand dollars (\$1,936,000.00);

WHEREAS, the City Council approved the required City grant matching funds of \$484,000.00 in the City's 2024 Annual Budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds and determines that authorizing the City Manager to enter into the attached IGA between the City and CDOT for the Project is and shall be in the best interest of the residents of the City.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Colorado, that:

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


