A RESOLUTION

APPROVING AN AMENDED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH
JEFFERSON COUNTY FOR USE OF AN INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AND
JOBS ACT/SAFE STREETS FOR ALL GRANT TO DEVELOP A COMPREHENSIVE
SAFETY ACTION PLAN

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 29-1-203 and § 29-1-203.5 as amended, the City of Lakewood (the “City”) and Jefferson County (the “County”) have the authority to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA);

WHEREAS, in 2023, the City entered into an IGA with the County regarding the development of a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan that will equip the City and County with specific recommendations on mitigating crash patterns and reducing crash potential, while prioritizing underserved and historically underrepresented areas, and identifying costs, opportunities, and barriers, thereby resulting in safer mobility within Jefferson County (the “Project”);

WHEREAS, the Project is funded by a \$545,000 Jobs Act/Safe Streets for All grant from the United States Department of Transportation, which requires local cost sharing of \$136,250;

WHEREAS, the City’s local share match is \$80,000.00, which was previously approved by City Council in the 2023 budget;

WHEREAS, the original IGA required the City to pay its local share match directly to the consultant hired by the County for completion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the County now desires and the City agrees to amend the original IGA to require the City to pay its local share match directly to the County, rather than to the consultant;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lakewood:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby finds and determines that authorizing the City Manager to enter into the Amended Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA), attached hereto as Attachment A and incorporated herein, between the City of Lakewood (the “City”) and Jefferson County (the “County”) is and shall be in the best interest of the residents of the City, and hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into the Amended IGA with the County on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. The City’s Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized and directed to pay amounts not to exceed eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000.00) for the City’s local share as contemplated by the IGA.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
