A RESOLUTION

APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION REGARDING SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS ALONG URBAN STREET BETWEEN STOBER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND WEST 26TH AVENUE

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 29-1-203 and § 29-1-203.5 as amended, the City of Lakewood (the “City”) and the Colorado Department of Transportation (“CDOT”) have the authority to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA);

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration approved CDOT’s Surface Transportation Improvement Program (“STIP”), and authorized federal funding for the same;

WHEREAS, the City applied for a federal grant to add sidewalk, curb and gutter, and curb ramps on the east side of Urban Street, and on the north side of West 26th Avenue from Urban Street to Taft Court, along with retaining wall construction and minor storm sewer replacement, (the “Project”);

WHEREAS, the City’s application for federal grant funding for the Project, was approved, and CDOT, through its STIP and Stewardship Agreement with the federal government will disburse the awarded federal funds, subject to the requirement that the City enter into an IGA with CDOT for use of the federal funds;

WHEREAS, the City and CDOT negotiated an IGA outlining all terms and conditions for the Project;

WHEREAS, the proposed IGA requires the City to contribute “Local Agency Funds” in the amount of one hundred ninety eight thousand, three hundred and sixty three dollars (\$198,363.00), and for a federal contribution, to be distributed by CDOT, in the amount of seven hundred ninety three thousand, four hundred and fifty dollars (\$793,450.00); and

WHEREAS, the City’s “Local Agency Funds” will be contributed via Capital Improvement Fund dollars that were appropriated in the 2025 annual budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lakewood:

SECTION1. The City Council hereby finds and determines that authorizing the City Manager to enter into an IGA, attached hereto as Attachment A and incorporated herein, between the City of Lakewood and the Colorado Department of Transportation for sidewalk improvements along the east side of Urban Street, and on the north side of West 26th Avenue from Urban Street to Taft Court, along with retaining wall construction and minor storm sewer replacement is and shall be in the best interest of the residents of the

City of Lakewood, and hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into the IGA with the Colorado Department of Transportation on behalf of the City of Lakewood.

SECTION 2. The City's Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized and directed to pay amounts not to exceed one hundred ninety-eight thousand, three hundred and sixty three dollars (\$198,363.00) for the City's share of the Project.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon signature following adoption.
