WHEREAS, Alison McKenney Brown has served the City of Lakewood in the capacity of City Attorney since January, 2021;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lakewood:

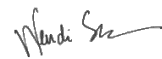
